A Bit of History

There is no fee to participate. All stories will be professionally edited prior to publication. Each writer is entitled to purchase copies of the book at cost (\$6), sell them at the retail price of \$20, with the understanding that a percentage of the proceeds from sales are to be donated to a charity related to the topic of the anthology. Charitable organizations related to the topic of the anthology are also entitled to purchase copies at cost, and retain the proceeds from sales.

Monday, September 20, 2021: Deadline for book orders
and accompanying payment
Friday, October 8, 2021: Books will be available
